Celebrate the solar eclipse with these fun and tasty treats. Whether you make it sweet or savory, these addition to your celestial celebration are bound to satisfy your family.

## Eclipse Cookies



Collect:

- Chocolate Sandwich Cookies (like Oreos)
- Plain round sugar cookies, slightly larger than the Oreos
- Frosting

Create:

Use the frosting to “glue” one Oreo to the center of each round sugar cookie. The Oreo represents the Moon and the sugar cookie is the Sun peeking around the edge. Don’t forget the milk, oat milk, or whatever else you love to dip your cookies in!

## Galaxy Punch



Collect:

- Berry Blue Typhoon Hawaiian Punch, chilled
- Sprite, chilled
- Rainbow Sherbet
- Star-Shaped Ice Cube Trays or Reusable Star Ice Cubes, optional

Create:

1. Mix one part Hawaiian Punch with one part Sprite.
2. Add star-shaped ice cubes, if desired.
3. Top with Rainbow Sherbet.
4. Enjoy!



## Out of This World Finger Foods

Collect:

- A Variety of Fruits, Meats, and Cheeses that can be easily cut with a cookie cutter.
- Star, Sun, and Moon Cookie Cutters

Create:

1. Cut food items with cookie cutters.
2. Arrange them on a tray or charcuterie board.
3. Watch them disappear as your crew devours them.
4. Oh, and feel free to add tomatoes, berries, and grapes for variety.

## Moon Bites

Collect:

- 1 8 oz. pkg cream cheese, softened
- 36 Chocolate Sandwich Cookies
- 4 pkgs of 4 oz white baking chocolate
- Wax Paper

Create:

1. Crunch cookies into fine crumbs.
2. Mix cream cheese and cookie crumbs.
3. Shape into 1" balls.
4. Freeze for 10 minutes.
5. In the meantime, melt white baking chocolate.
6. Remove balls from the freezer and dip them into melted chocolate.
7. Place on a wax paper-lined pan on a cookie sheet.
8. Refrigerate for 1 hour until firm.
